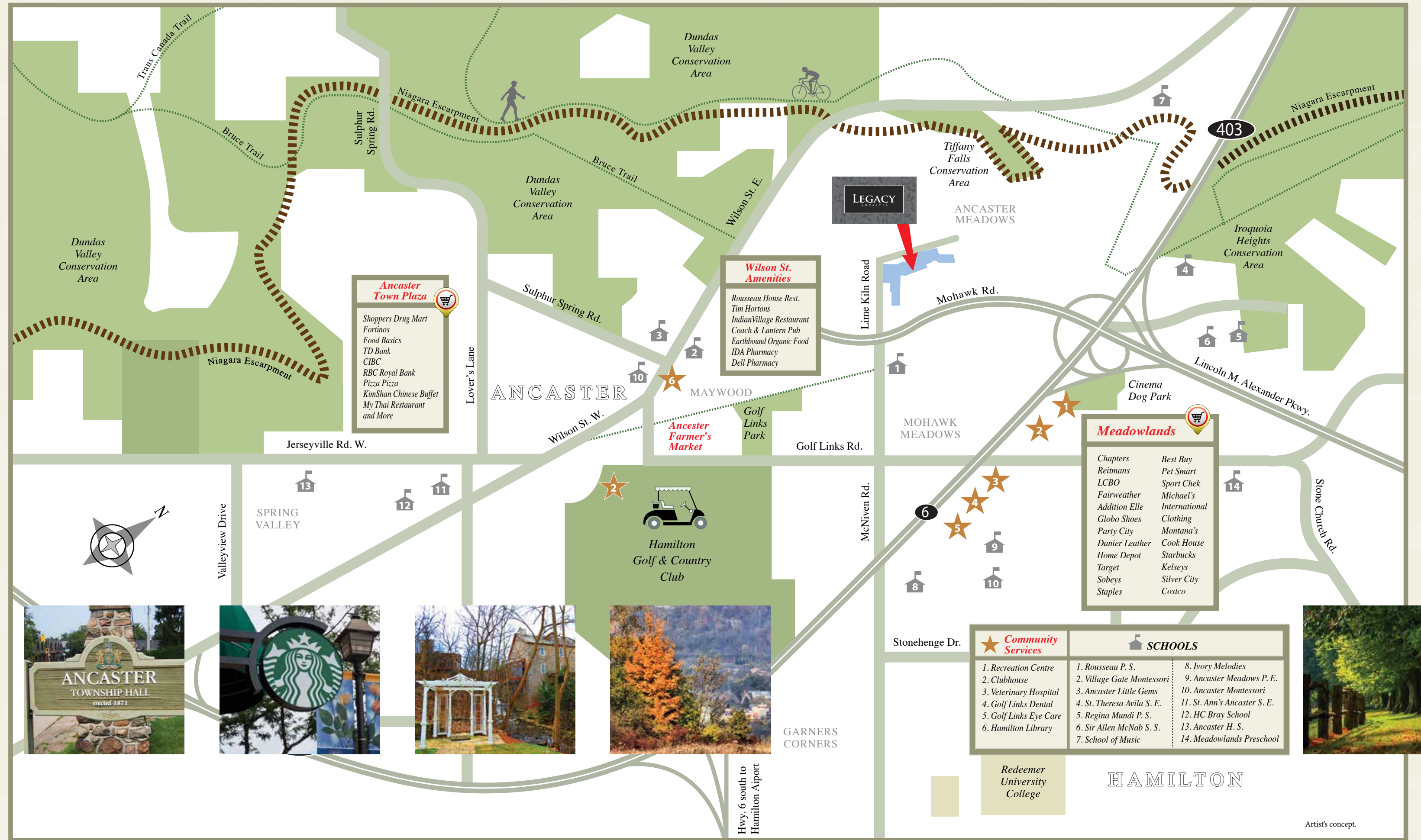
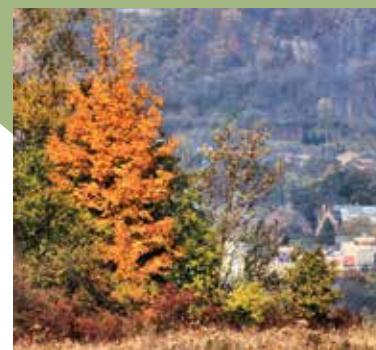
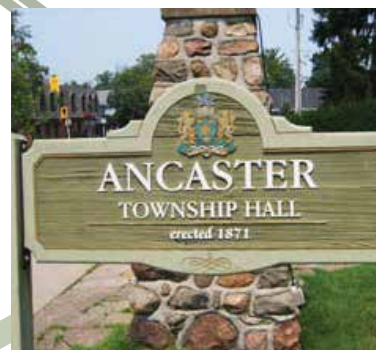


CLOSE TO ALL THE CITY AMENITIES
